The Gladys Brooks Foundation was created under the Will of Gladys Brooks Thayer of New York. Its purpose is to provide for the intellectual, moral and physical welfare of the people of this country by establishing and supporting non-profit libraries, educational institutions, hospitals and clinics.

The grantmaking body of the Foundation is the Governing Board. As a matter of policy, the Foundation provides grants only to institutions/organizations which are exempt from tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and are not private foundations as defined in section 509 of the Code.

In 2024 the Governing Board concentrated on grants to private not-for-profit publicly supported educational institutions, libraries, and clinics. The following institutions received grant payments from the Foundation in 2024:
